Headteacher's Headlines

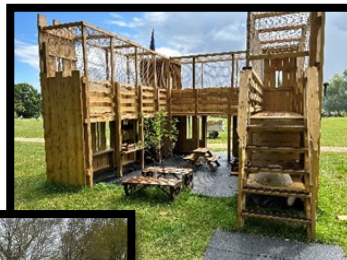
Dear Residents,
